The heavy manufacturing sector is defined by physically demanding work, repetitive tasks, and complex operations that elevate the risk of workplace injuries. To stay competitive and safeguard its workforce, a leading manufacturer partnered with ATI Worksite Solutions (AWS) to proactively strengthen its safety culture and reduce the impact of musculoskeletal (MSK) injuries.

The program deployed embedded AWS specialists across seven key sites, supported by remote and field coverage at additional locations. This hybrid model provided employees with immediate access to on-site care, early symptom intervention, and expert ergonomic guidance—helping prevent minor issues from developing into costly OSHA recordables.

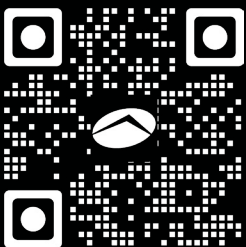
